- I. A Prophet's Message fits his Context
  - A. Date and location (1:1, 7:12-15) Bethel, Israel, c.760 BC
  - B. Background information
    - 1. Bethel (1 Kings 12:26-31)
    - Jeroboam II (2 Kings 14:23-27), 793-753 BC, & Azariah/Uzziah (2 Kings 15:1-7), 791-739 BC
    - 3. Assyrian weakness and Israelite "Golden Age"
  - C. Occasion rampant corruption, oppression, idolatry, and immorality
  - D. Message
    - 1. Accusation (2:6-8)
    - 2. Judgment (3:1-2, 3:11-4:2)
    - 3. Repentance (5:4-6,14-15)
    - 4. The Day of the Lord (5:18-24; 8:9-12; 9:11-15)
- II. <u>Interpretation from the Prophet's Perspective</u> Acts 15:13-19
- III. <u>Understanding use of Signs and Symbols</u> 7:1-9, 8:1-2, 9:1-10 (also wordplay, metaphor, analogy, metonymy, & anthropomorphism)
  - "Inerrant" & "Literal" are NOT the same thing!
- Poetic/symbolic language is not less inspired or authoritative, but we must be careful to be less dogmatic in how we approach it.
